## REHOBOTH CHILDREN'S HOME, INC.

Rehoboth Children's Home, Inc. (RCHI), founded in 1981, seeks to support disadvantaged children and young people in the Philippines. In many cases, the children for whatever reason are no longer able to live with their own families and they come to live at Rehoboth where all their needs are provided. In other cases, the youngsters are able to stay with their families, but the family cannot afford to pay for the education of their child. In these circumstances, Rehoboth assists with meeting these costs through the Rehoboth Educational Assistance Program (REAP). RCHI is in Sta. Maria, Camiling, Tarlac on the northern island of Luzon in the Philippines.

### WHAT IS THE 100 CLUB?

An association of civic-oriented individuals willing to share P100 a month /P1200 a year in order to help a child at RCHI be sent to school.

Contributions will be used to finance the educational needs of a child such as tuition fees, school supplies, school contributions and allowances.

### WHAT DOES THE 100 CLUB DO?

Funds generated through the 100 Club are designated to help cover the costs of education for Rehoboth's residents as well as REAP scholars. This can include tuition and other fees, school uniforms, school supplies, and any other expenses associated with a student's education.

The residents and REAP scholars of RCHI range in age from elementary to college, so your contribution could help a child who is just beginning, or a young adult who is preparing to graduate and find work.

Many of these students are planning to become teachers, nurses, social workers or engineers. Therefore a contribution becomes an investment, not only in one Filipino child, but in future generations as well!
